

2009 Summer Overseas Short-term Missions Supported by CCCNJ (1/3)

I. Central Asia Kyrgyzstan mission (must fill up the application form by 2/1/2009)

- (1) Corporation Organization: Mercy Charitable Christian Fundation (MCCF) run by Elder Yang's organization in Kyrgyzstan
- (2) Schedule of field trip will be most likely from late June to July/2009
- (3) Team Members: 6~8 (include 1~2 adult leaders).
- (4) Qualification:
 - a. 11+ grader or higher, college is preferred
 - b. Having been baptized is required
 - c. Domestic mission experience is required & overseas mission experience is preferred
 - d. Willing to fully obey the guidance and leadership from team leader once accepted for mission
- (5) Total Duration: 6+ weeks including the mission trip (3+ weeks) & training (2~3 weeks)
- (6) Budget will be around \$2,200 per person paid by 30% own-pocket & 70% fund raising
- (7) Field major programs:
 - a. VBS camp in Christian school,
 - b. Many street evangelism opportunities in MCCF's playground and locals,
 - c. Exciting to assist orphanage program in mountain camp,
 - d. Visiting Kara-Balta Christian school, other MCCF's schools and local mission organizations,
 - e. Opportunities to visit the resident and kid's family to share the God's message.
 - f. Opportunities to visit local scenery places (lake, mountain, etc)
- (8) Kyrgyzstan is very beautiful country and has nickname "Switzerland in Central Asia". Most of its area is in the high mountain area. 77% of their people are the Muslim's religion with only 1~2% Christian. The country is still underdeveloped and most of the local residents are considered poor

II. Taiwan VGM mission (must fill up the application form by 2/1/2009)

- (1) Corporation Organization: Village Gospel Mission located in Southern of Taiwan
- (2) Schedule of field trip will be any consecutive two weeks from 7/4~25/2009
- (3) Team Members: 7~10 (include 1~2 adult leaders)
- (4) Qualifications:
 - a. 10+ grader or higher.
 - b. Having been baptized is required.
 - c. Domestic/overseas mission experience is preferred, but will accept the church VBS leader experience such as teacher/small group leader role or attending local evangelism.
 - d. Willing to fully obey the guidance and leadership from team leader once accepted for mission
 - e. Prefer Mandarin speaking but not mandatory
- (5) Total Duration: 5~6 weeks including the mission trip (2+ weeks) & training (3+ weeks)
- (6) Budget will be around \$1,700 per person paid by 30% own-pocket & 70% fund raising
- (7) We will team up with Taiwan's college coworkers to host the bilingual camps in the local middle or elementary school of the village. Most of the kids and residents are non-believers or has no chance to hear the gospel message. Locals are hesitant or even resistant to Christian's message.
- (8) Field major program:
 - a. Camps in local schools for English teaching, evangelical drama/dance programs, Christian song lessons, personal testimony,
 - b. Chances for resident & kid's family visitation
 - c. Many prayer meetings with local workers and in-town walking prayers
 - d. Attending local churches & worship
- (9) CCCNJ has served VGM summer mission since 2004, and almost every members served this mission have come back with many joys and blessings granted by the Lord. We believe the people joining 2009's VGM mission will receive the same life-changed experience as God gives.

III. Far-East Project Serve (must fill up the application form by 2/1/2009)

- (1) Corporation Organization: (still working on it)
- (2) Temporary schedule of field trip will be most likely in early August/2009 for 1~2 weeks
- (3) Team Members: 5~6 (include 1~2 adult leaders)
- (4) Qualification:
 - a. 12+ grader or college students
 - b. Having been baptized is required
 - c. Domestic mission experience is required & overseas experience is preferred.
 - d. Willing to fully obey the guidance and leadership from team leader once accepted for mission
 - e. Prefer Mandarin speaking and will be tested for qualified consideration
- (5) Total Duration: 5~6 weeks including the mission trip (2+ weeks) & training (3+ weeks)
- (6) Budget will be around \$1,900 per person paid by 30% by own-pocket & 70% by fund raising
- (7) Field major programs:
 - a. Camps in local schools or orphanage for English teaching, Christian song lessons, crafts, personal testimony.
 - b. Prayer meetings with local workers & walking prayer possibility
 - c. Attending local churches & worship
- (8) Special requirement: You must be very low-key during the field trip and be able to bear a very inconvenient environment, such as insects bites, dirty toilets, etc. Expect to meet the unexpected things during the trip. Flexible attitude is very important to have. However, God will grant you an eye-opening and unbelievable blessings on this trip.
